Date	Location	Leaders
Oct 4	Highland Forest: We'll walk the grounds of the historic Paine Estate, including the wooded loop of a 19th century harness-racing track. Park on Wildflower Lane near the trailhead.	Ann Wiedie and Linda Nelson
Nov 1	College Pond: Take a walk around College Pond's beautiful pond, woods, and fields. Park at Burchard Park near the snack shack, 269 Concord Road.	Gail Palmer
Dec 6	Sears Land and Melone Homestead: Enjoy a special holiday treat and explore remnants of the old Sears Estate. We will walk over the river and through the woods leaving right from Town Green. Meet at the old watering trough.	Diana Chaplin
Jan 3	Jericho – South: Starting at Lamson Park on Town House Road, we will walk a mostly flat 3-mile loop in Weston's original "town forest" to French's Field.	Joel Angiolillo
Feb 7	Jericho – North: Starting at Burchard Park, we will walk west into the wilds of Jericho Forest. The walk will include a bit of the Bay Circuit Trail.	Joel Angiolillo
Mar 7	Hubbard Forest: Walk from Burt Field through the Hubbard Forest and into the neighborhood of Orchard Avenue, site of what was Weston's third largest estate, owned by Charles Townsend Hubbard in the 1860s. Park at Burt Field on Gail Rd.	Finn Caspersen
Apr 4	Ogilvie Town Forest: We will start in Lincoln and walk in Weston's largest and wildest forest. Park at the trailhead at the end of Stonehedge Road in Lincoln.	Jen Potter and Sarah Maas Scheuplein
May 2	Weston Reservoir: A meditative quiet walk to appreciate the towering pines. After walking about 2 miles along the south side of the reservoir, we will gather in a circle to share observations. 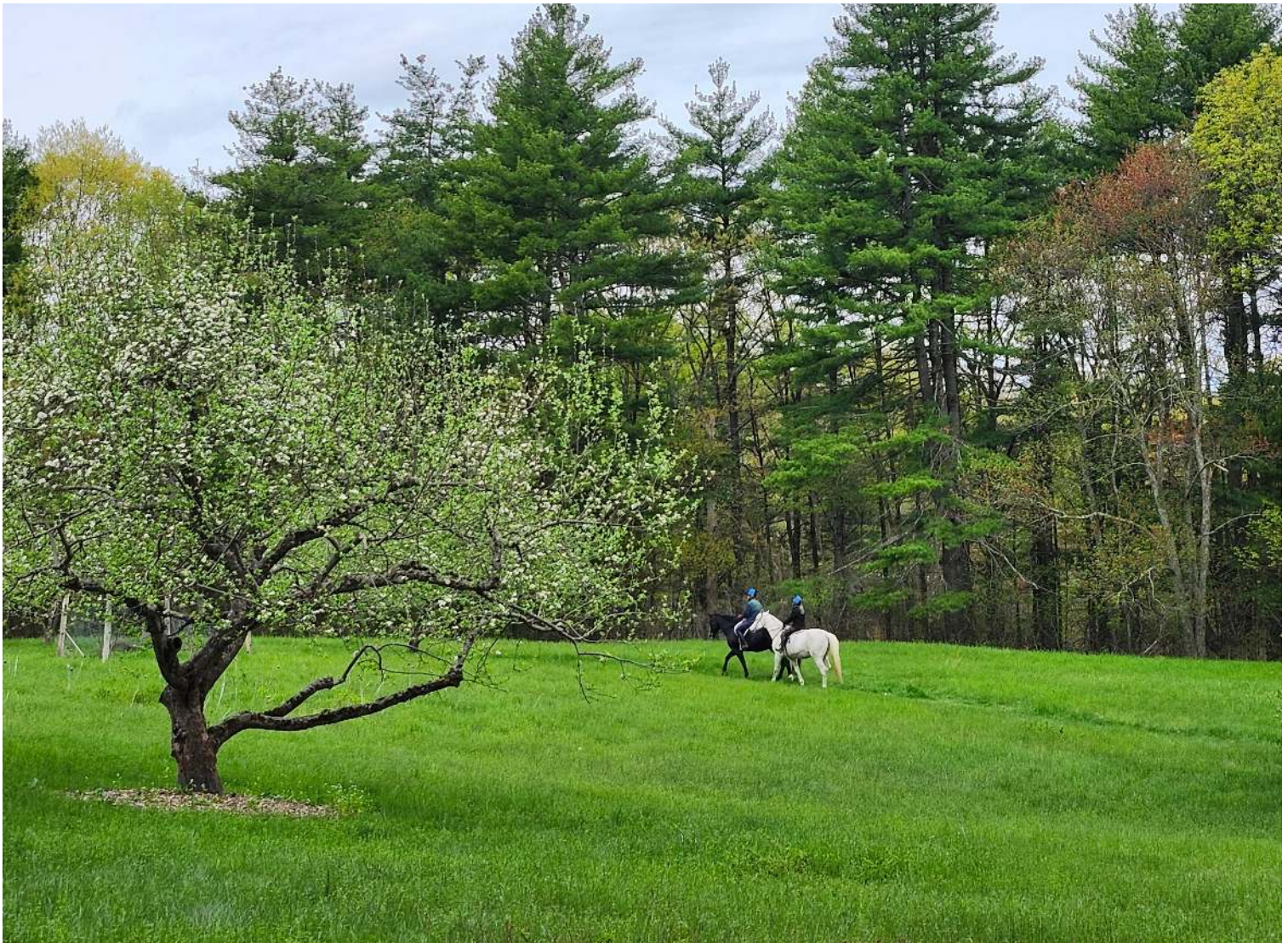
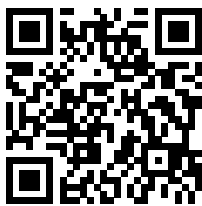
